Exhibition details

Exhibition Period: November 18 (Sat) – December 1 (Fri), 2017

Exhibition Site: Skytown Gallery, Narita City Cultural Arts Center

Entry qualifications

Elementary and junior high school children (Children aged between six and fifteen.)

Requirements for application

- Theme: "Food"
(Artwork should be flat and picture frames should not be used)
- Type: Watercolors, crayons, pastel crayons, wood prints etc.
- Size: Maximum 39.2 cmx54.2cm
- Number of exhibits: **Entries are limited to one picture per person, and up to 10 per city, 10 cities per country, in principle, due to the space limitations at the exhibition site. If sizes are exceeded, some artworks might not be exhibited after screening.**
- Ownership: The ownership and copyright of the exhibits will belong to the promoter.
- Other: Artwork will not be returned, since they will be utilized for an indefinite period keeping them with greatest care.

Application procedure

- (1) In submitting your works, please apply through a school or an organization.
Individual applications are not accepted. Prizes will be awarded and sent to the school or organization.
- (2) The Exhibits List should be filled in according to each school or group and be presented with the pictures.

- (3) Exhibit Form should be pasted on the back of the artwork fitting to the directions of it (ups and downs; right and left) after filling in the prescribed form.
- (4) The prizes for the exhibits are to be sent to the schools or groups. Please fill in the required information in alphabet and in BLOCK LETTER. Be careful not to make any mistakes.

Deadline for application

September 8(Fri), 2017

Please abide by the closing date to avoid any delay in exhibition preparations.
